Salvation Guide

1. Acknowledge to God that you're a sinner.

All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. (Romans 3:23)

2. Believe that Jesus Christ is God's only begotten Son and that Jesus Christ died for your sins, and has resurrected from the dead.

Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household. (Acts 16:31)

3. Confess your sins to Jesus Christ.

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9)

What Is The Word Of God?

The Bible contains God's Word that was written over a period of approximately 1,500 years by godly men who were inspired by the Holy Spirit. It will tell you everything you need to know to grow in your spiritual life. Because God speaks through His Word, you'll get to know Him more, and to learn of His ways.

Why is reading the Word important?

- 1. It feeds our spirit.

 Matthew 4:4
- 2. It renews our minds.

 Romans 12:2
- 3. It guides our decision and paths. Psalm 119:105
- **4.** It equips us for every good work. *2 Timothy 3:16-17*
- 5. It strengthens us against the enemy. 1 John 2:14



Practical tips for Bible reading:

- 1. Set aside a regular time and place to read the Bible.
- 2. Have a Bible reading plan.
- 3. God loves to show you who He is. Pray for Him to teach you before you read!
- 4. Look out for phrases that jump out at you as you read & ask God to show you what it means, and how to apply it in your life.
- 5. Reflect and record what you have learned.

What Is Prayer?


Simply put, prayer is talking with God! For any relationship to grow, there must be regular communication. Prayer is one of the greatest privileges we have as a child of God. Just think, the God of all creation wants to hear from you! That's why we end our prayers with "In Jesus' name we pray, Amen!". It's through Jesus that our prayers are accepted and heard by God.

We pray because...

- 1. That's how we build a relationship with God
- 2. God hears & answers prayers. 1 John 5:14-15
- 3. It's God's will that we pray.

 1 Thess 5:17-18





- 1. Find a quiet place.
- 2. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you.
- 3. Pray out loud.
- 4. Be specific.
- 5. Listen to what He is saying*.
- 6. Make prayer a lifestyle.

*God speaks primarily through His Word. That's why we should use prayer to respond to what God is saying as we read His Word. God can also speak to us through other believers, in worship, through circumstances, visions, and even through a still small voice that nudges us in a certain direction. Regardless of how He speaks, He will never contradict His Word, and whatever He says will always bring glory to Himself.



Prayer

What Is Water Baptism?

Water baptism is an act of faith where we identify with Jesus Christ by being immersed completely in the water, and then being brought back up. The immersion in water symbolises your death to sin (the burial of your old nature). Coming out of the water represents the resurrection to the new life in Christ Jesus.

Water baptism is an essential part of the Christian birth after salvation.

- 1. It's an act of obedience. Matthew 28:19
- 2. It identifies us with Christ & His Body. Galations 3:27
- 3. It empowers us to live a new and glorious life. Romans 6:4
- 4. It breaks satan's power over our lives.

The best time to get baptised is as soon as possible! Talk to your pastor about setting a date and time.

Further Study	1 Peter 3:21; Acts 22:16; Colossians 2:12 What is the significance of water baptism in our faith in Christ?

What Is God's Will For My Life?

This is a very important question that must be answered. Since Christ is now your Master, you must learn what He wants you to do for your life! Jesus said that His true disciples are those who know and do the Father's will (Mark 3:35).

The Bible reveals that it is God's will for us to be:

- 1. Saved 1 Timothy 2:3-4, 2 Peter 3:9
- 2. Filled by the Holy Spirit. Ephesians 5:17-18
- **3. Set apart** 1 Thessalonians 4:3-7
- **4. Submitted** 1 Peter 2:13-15
- **5. Thankful** 1 Thessalonians 5:18
- **6. A soul winner** *2 Timothy 4:2,5*Sharing our faith is not just a requirement, but an enormous blessing! He's the Good News for a reason.

How do I tell people about Jesus?

- 1. Share what your life was like before Christ:
 - Inward problem (rejection, loneliness etc)
 - Describe how it affected your life.
- 2. Tell of the change in your heart after Jesus came into your life.
- 3. Invite them to receive the same life-changing experience!
